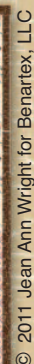

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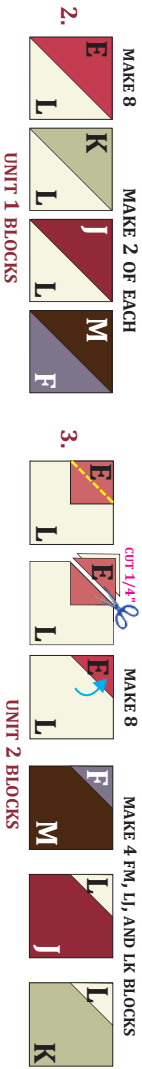

	A Sewing Stripe 3061-77 Ivory	1-3/4 YD	Fussy Cut: SEE DIAGRAM A, (bottom right) (2) 6-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip (LoF). (2) 6-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip (LoF).
	B Sewing Allover 3062-77 Ivory	1/2 YD	Fussy Cut: SEWING MOTIFS (6) 4-1/2" squares.
	C Sewing Words 3063-79 Brown	1 YD	Fussy Cut: SEE DIAGRAM C, (bottom right) (2) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" (LoF). (2) 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" (LoF).
	D Buttons 3064-01 Pink	1/4 YD	(2) 5-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally to yield (8) QST.
	E Buttons 3064-11 Red	1/4 YD	(4) 4-7/8" squares. (8) 2-1/2" squares.
	F Buttons 3064-55 Blue	1/4 YD	(2) 5-1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally to yield (8) QST. (2) 4-7/8" squares. (4) 2-1/2" squares.
	G Needlepoint Stripe 3065-79 Tan	1/4 YD	(4) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.
	H Sewing Foulard 3066-11 Red	1/4 YD	(4) 4-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally to yield (8) HST.
	I Sewing Foulard 3066-79 Brown	1/4 YD	(4) 4-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally to yield (8) HST.
	J Lace Stripe 3067-11 Red	1/4 YD	(2) 4-7/8" squares. (4) 4-1/2" squares.
	K Lace Stripe 3067-44 Green	1/4 YD	(2) 4-7/8" squares. (4) 4-1/2" squares.
	L Scissors 3068-77 Ivory	1/2 YD	(8) 4-7/8" squares. (8) 4-1/2" squares. (8) 2-1/2" squares.
	M Crackle Texture 3069-79 Brown	2/3 YD	(2) 4-7/8" squares. (4) 4-1/2" squares. (5) 2-1/4" x WOF strips, BINDING.

HST/QST=HALF/QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE | LoF/WoF=LENGTH/WIDTH OF FABRIC

- 1. UNIT 1 BLOCKS:** Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) **E** and (1) **L** 4-7/8" squares. Pair squares right sides together and sew 1/4" on each side of drawn diagonal line (**1a**). Cut squares apart on the drawn line (**1b**). *Fold triangles out and press 1b. seams towards darker fabric (2).* Square block to 4-1/2". Make (8) **EL** blocks.

2. Repeat step 1. to make (4) of each **KL**, **IL**, and **FM** blocks (**2**).



- 3. UNIT 2 BLOCKS:** Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) **E** 2-1/2" square. Place **E** square on one corner of (1) **L** 4-1/2" square. Sew on diagonal line from corner to corner. Remove excess fabric 1/4" from seam allowance, fold resulting triangle out and press both seams towards the triangle, as shown in diagram (**3**). Square **EL** block to 4-1/2". Repeat steps for following corner paired blocks **FM**, **IL**, and **LK** (**3**).

- 4. BLOCK ONE:** Sew Unit 1 and Unit 2 Blocks together to make (2) **FM**, (2) **IL**, (2) **LK**, and (4) **EL** Spool Blocks. Square blocks to 8-1/2". Refer to *QUILT DIAGRAM* below.

- 5. BLOCK TWO:** Sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **B** 4-1/2" square. Repeat for top and bottom using **G** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Square **GB** block to 8-1/2". Make 2 **GB** Block Twos.

- 6. BLOCK THREE:** Sew (1) **D** 5-1/4" QST to all four sides of (1) **B** 4-1/2" square. Press seams out towards the triangles. Next sew (1) **I** 4-7/8" HST to all four sides of **DB** block. Square block to 8-1/2". Make 2 of each, **BDI** and **BFH** blocks. See *QUILT DIAGRAM* below.

- 7. QUILT ASSEMBLY** Assemble Blocks 1- 3 into three rows of four blocks each. See *QUILT DIAGRAM*.
8. BORDER ASSEMBLY Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip and (1) **A** 6-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip together via long edge, refer to *QUILT PHOTO* for proper direction of **A** and **C** fabrics. Make 2 **AC** strips and sew one to each side of quilt top.

9. Repeat step 8, using **C** 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips and **A** 6-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips. Make 2 **AC** strips. Next add to ends of **AC** strips (1) **EL** and (1) **LK** Block Ones, see *QUILT DIAGRAM* for proper placement of **EL** and **KL** blocks. Sew UNITS to top and bottom of quilt top. Note proper placement of border strips.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin with safety pins. When done quilting, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.
