



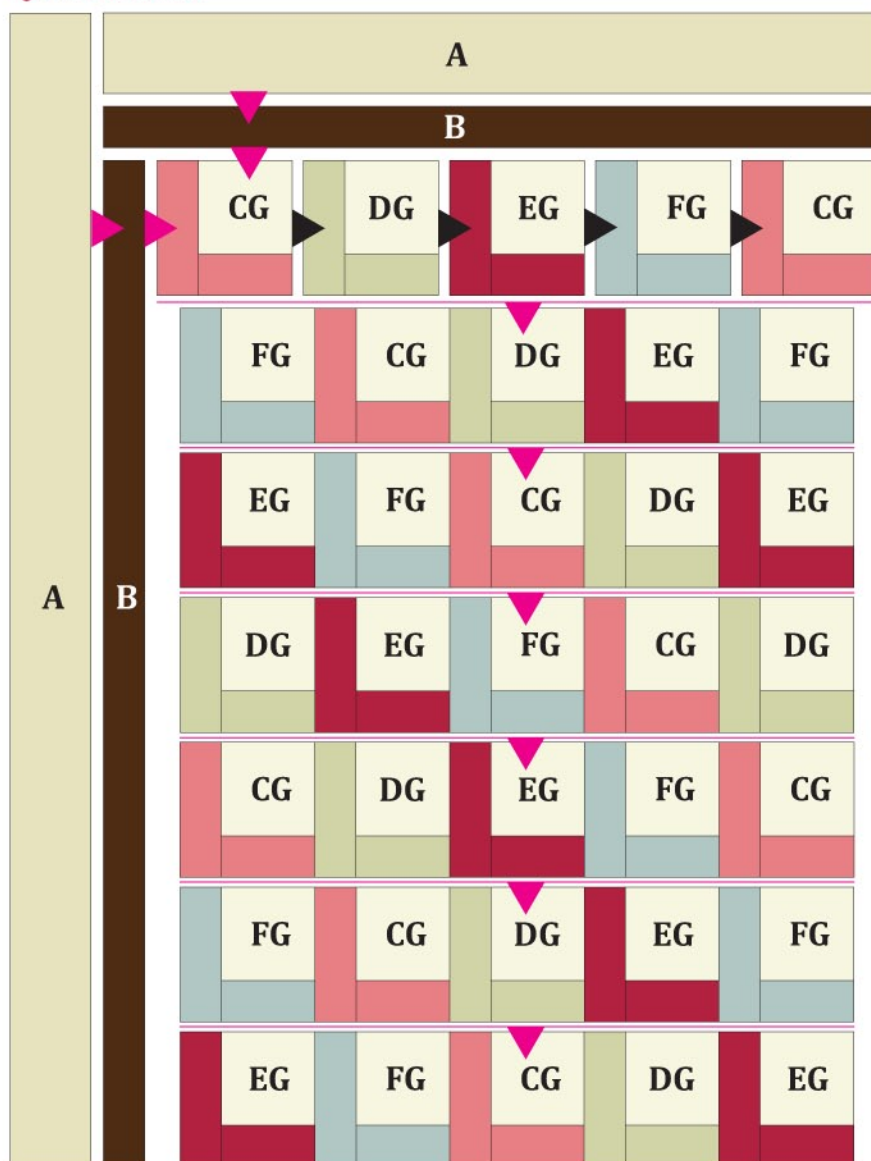




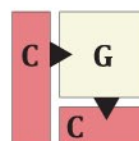

	<b>A</b> Sewing Stripe 3061-77 Ivory	1 YD	(2) 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips. (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. *Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips.
	<b>B</b> Crackle Texture 3069-79 Brown	3/4 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips. (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. *Subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips. (6) 2-1/4" x WOF; BINDING.
	<b>C</b> Lace Strip 3067-01 Pink	1/4 YD	(9) 2" x 5-1/2" strips. (9) 2" x 7" strips.
	<b>D</b> Sewing Foulard 3066-44 Light Green	1/4 YD	(8) 2" x 5-1/2" strips. (8) 2" x 7" strips.
	<b>E</b> Buttons 3064-11 Red	1/4 YD	(9) 2" x 5-1/2" strips. (9) 2" x 7" strips.
	<b>F</b> Needlestripe 3065-55 Blue	1/4 YD	(9) 2" x 5-1/2" strips. (9) 2" x 7" strips.
	<b>G</b> Sewing Squares 3060-77 Ivory	1 YD	FUSSY CUT: (35) random 5-1/2" squares.

\*SEW STRIPS TOGETHER VIA SHORT ENDS, THEN SUBCUT AS INDICATED | WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC.

## QUILT DIAGRAM



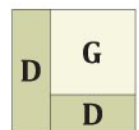
## BLOCK ASSEMBLY



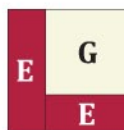
1. Sew (1) **C** 2" x 5-1/2" strip to base of (1) **G** 5-1/2" square. Press seam towards strip. Then sew (1) **C** 2" x 7" to left side of **CG** unit. Press seam towards strip. Square block to 6-1/2". Make 9 **CG** blocks.

**Note:** Be careful not to repeat **G** square when assembling sets of blocks, per strip group.

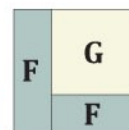
2. Repeat step 1. to make the following blocks:

3. **QUILT TOP** Refer to *QUILT DIAGRAM* to assemble quilt top in 7 rows of 5 blocks. **Note proper placement of blocks.**

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

4. **INNER BORDER:** Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to each side of quilt top. Next sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top, see *QUILT DIAGRAM*.

5. **OUTER BORDER:** Sew (1) **A** 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top. Then sew (1) **A** 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" strip to each side of quilt top. **Note pattern orientation of A stripe, refer to QUILT PHOTO.**

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

FINISHED SIZE: 42" x 54".
